

MEMORANDUM FOR All Audition Candidates

SUBJECT: Adjustment to Maximum Age for Non-Prior Service Applicants

1. Effective 1 April 2011, the United States Army Recruiting Command (USAREC) has lowered the maximum enlistment age for non-prior service applicants in the United States Army. Candidates wishing to submit packets for consideration for any currently posted vacancy must adhere to the new age restrictions. There are no exceptions to this policy.
2. The adjustment in maximum enlistment age now requires any prospective enlistee to depart for Basic Combat Training on or before their 35th birthday. The only exception to this policy is for candidates who have prior military service.
3. Local unit policy requires a candidate to meet all military initial enlistment qualifications prior to being offered a position with the West Point Band. Candidates who do not meet the new age requirement cannot currently be offered a live audition.
